³³ Standing up that hour, they returned to Jerusalem. They found the eleven and those with them gathered together, ³⁴ saying,

"The Lord was really raised and he was seen by Simon!"

³⁵ Then they began explaining the things on the Way and how Jesus was known to them during the breaking of bread. ³⁶ While they were speaking of these things, Jesus stood in the middle of them and said to them,

"Harmony to you!"

³⁷ Being terrified and becoming frightened, they began assuming they saw a breath. ³⁸ Jesus said to them,

"Why have you been agitated and why are considerations coming up in your hearts? ³⁹ See my hands and my feet! I am myself! Touch me and see! A breath does not have flesh and bone, as you are seeing I have."

⁴⁰ While saying this, Jesus showed them his hands and feet. ⁴¹ While they were still being untrustful because of joy and marveling, he said to them,

"Do you have anything edible here?"

⁴² They gave him part of a cooked fish ⁴³ and, receiving it, he ate in their sight. ⁴⁴ Jesus said to them,

"These are my words which I spoke to you, while being with you. It is necessary for all the things written about me in the Torah of Moses, the prophets, and the Psalms to be fulfilled."

⁴⁵ Then he opened their minds to understand the writings. ⁴⁶ Jesus said to them,

"So it is written:

The Anointed is to suffer and stand up from among the dead on the third day. ⁴⁷ Transformation, for freedom from rebellions, is to be proclaimed at his name to all the nations, beginning from Jerusalem.

- ⁴⁸ You are testimonies of these things! ⁴⁹ I am sending the commitment of my Father upon you. Sit in the city till you put on power from on high."
- ⁵⁰ He brought them up to Bethany and, lifting up his hands, he honored them. ⁵¹ While he honored them, he stood apart from them ⁵² and they returned to Jerusalem with great joy. ⁵³ Through everything, they were in the temple-complex honoring the Creator.
