

¹⁸ While he is saying these things to them, look, one ruler, after coming, was pledging-allegiance to him, saying,

“My daughter just now died! But after coming, place your hand upon her and she will live!”

¹⁹ And after rising up, Jesus and his learners followed him. ²⁰ And look, a woman, after bleeding for twelve years and after coming up behind Jesus, touched the edge of his garment. ²¹ For she was saying to herself,

“If only I might touch his garment, then I will be saved!”

²² And Jesus, after turning and seeing her, said,

“Be courageous, daughter, your faith has saved you!”

And the woman was saved from that hour. ²³ And Jesus, after coming into the house of the ruler and after seeing the flute-players and the crowd being noisy, ²⁴ was saying,

“Go away! For the girl did not die, but she is sleeping.”

And they were mocking Jesus. ²⁵ And when the crowd was thrown out, Jesus entered and grasped the girl’s hand and the girl was raised up. ²⁶ And this news went out into all that land. ²⁷ While Jesus is leaving there, two blind men followed him, crying out and saying,

“Have mercy on us, Son of David!”

²⁸ And after coming into the house, the blind men came to him. And Jesus is saying to them,

“Are you trusting that I am able to do this?”

They are saying to him,

“Yes, Lord.”

²⁹ Then he touched their eyes, saying,

“According to your faith it must happen for you.”

³⁰ And their eyes were opened. And Jesus warned them, saying,

“See that no one knows!”

³¹ And after going out, they spoke of him in all of that land. ³² And while they were going out, look, they carried to Jesus a demon-possessed deaf man. ³³ And after the demon was thrown out, the deaf man spoke. And the crowds were amazed, saying,

“Nothing like this has ever appeared in Israel!”

³⁴ But the Pharisees were saying,

“With the ruler of the demons he is throwing out the demons!”

³⁵ And Jesus was going around to all the cities and villages, while teaching in their synagogues and proclaiming the Gospel of the Kingdom and healing every disease and every weakness. ³⁶ But after seeing the crowds, he had compassion on them, because they were wounded and thrown down, like sheep not having a shepherd. ³⁷ Then he is saying to his learners,

“The harvest is plentiful, but the workers are few. ³⁸ Therefore, beg the Lord of the harvest so that he may throw workers out into his harvest.”

^{10.1} And after summoning his twelve learners, he gave them authority over unclean spirits to throw them out and to heal every disease and every weakness. ² And the names of the twelve apostles are these: First, Simon, who is called Peter, and Andrew his brother. And Jacob, the one of Zebedee, and John his brother. ³ Philip and Bartholomew. Thomas and Matthew the tax-collector. Jacob, the one of Alphaeus, and Thaddaeus. ⁴ Simon, the Canaanite, and Judah, the Daggerman who also gave Jesus over. ⁵ Jesus sent out these twelve, after commanding them, saying,

“Do not go away into the way of the ethnicities and do not enter a city of the Samaritans. ⁶ But you must journey more to the destroyed sheep of the house of Israel.

⁷ And while journeying, you must proclaim, while saying, ‘The Kingdom of the Heavens is at hand!’ ⁸ Heal the sick. Raise the dead. Cleanse lepers. Throw out demons. You received freely, so you must freely give. ⁹ You must not acquire gold or silver or copper for your belts. ¹⁰ Nor a backpack for the way, nor two shirts, nor sandals, nor a staff. For the worker is worthy of his provision.

¹¹ But into whatever city or village you might enter, search for someone within it who is worthy and remain there until whenever you might leave. ¹² And while entering the house, greet it. ¹³ And if the house might be worthy, then bring your peace upon it. But if it might not be worthy, then your peace must return to you. ¹⁴ And whoever might not receive you nor listen to your words, while coming out of the house or that city, you must shake off the dust of your feet. ¹⁵ Amen, I am saying to you, it will be more endurable for the land of Sodom and Gomorrah on the day of judgment, than for that city.

¹⁶ Look, I am sending you as sheep in the middle of wolves. Therefore, be thoughtful like serpents and non-violent like doves. ¹⁷ Pay attention because of humans! For they will give you over to councils and they will whip you in their synagogues. ¹⁸ And you will be led, because of me, before governors and kings as a testimony to them and the ethnicities. ¹⁹ But whenever they give you over, do not worry about how or what you should say. For what you should say will be given to you in that hour. ²⁰ For you yourselves are not the ones speaking, but the Spirit of your Father is speaking in you. ²¹ And brother will give over brother to death and a father, a child. And children will rise up against parents and will kill them. ²² And you will be disowned by everyone because of my name. But the one remaining-patient to the finish will be saved.

²³ And whenever they are harassing you in this city, then flee to another. For amen, I am saying to you, you will never finish the cities of Israel until the Son of Humanity comes.

²⁴ A learner is not above the teacher nor is a slave above his lord. ²⁵ It is enough for the learner to become like his teacher and the slave like his lord. If they called the house-master Beelzebul, then how much more his house-members.

²⁶ Therefore, do not fear them. For nothing is covered which will not be uncovered. And hidden which will not be made known. ²⁷ What I am saying to you in darkness, you must speak in the light. And what you are hearing in the ear, you must proclaim on the rooftops. ²⁸ And do not fear those who kill the body, but are unable to kill the soul. Instead, fear more the one who is able to destroy both soul and body in the Hinnom Valley. ²⁹ Are not two little-birds being sold for a small-coin? Yet not one of them will fall upon the earth apart from your Father. ³⁰ So also for you! All the hairs of the head are numbered! ³¹ Therefore, do not fear! You yourselves are differing from many little birds.

³² Therefore, everyone who will say-yes to me before humans, I also will say-yes to him before my Father who is in the heavens. ³³ But whoever might say-no to me before humans, I also will say-no to him before my Father who is in the heavens.

³⁴ Do not suppose that I came to bring peace on the earth. I did not come to bring peace, but a sword. ³⁵ For I came to divide a human against his father and a daughter against her mother and a bride against her mother-in-law. ³⁶ The enemies of the human are his house-members. ³⁷ Whoever is loving father or mother above me is not worthy of me. And whoever is loving son or daughter above me is not worthy of me. ³⁸ And whoever is not taking his cross and following behind me is not worthy of me. ³⁹ Whoever is finding his soul, will destroy it. And whoever is destroying his soul, because of me, will find it. ⁴⁰ Whoever is receiving you, is receiving me. And whoever is receiving me, is receiving the one who sent me. ⁴¹ Whoever is receiving a prophet in the name of a prophet will get a prophet's reward. And whoever is receiving a righteous-person in the name of a righteous-person will get a righteous-person's reward. ⁴² And whoever might give-a-drink of only a cup of cold-water to one of these little ones in the name of a learner, amen I am saying to you, he will never destroy his reward."
