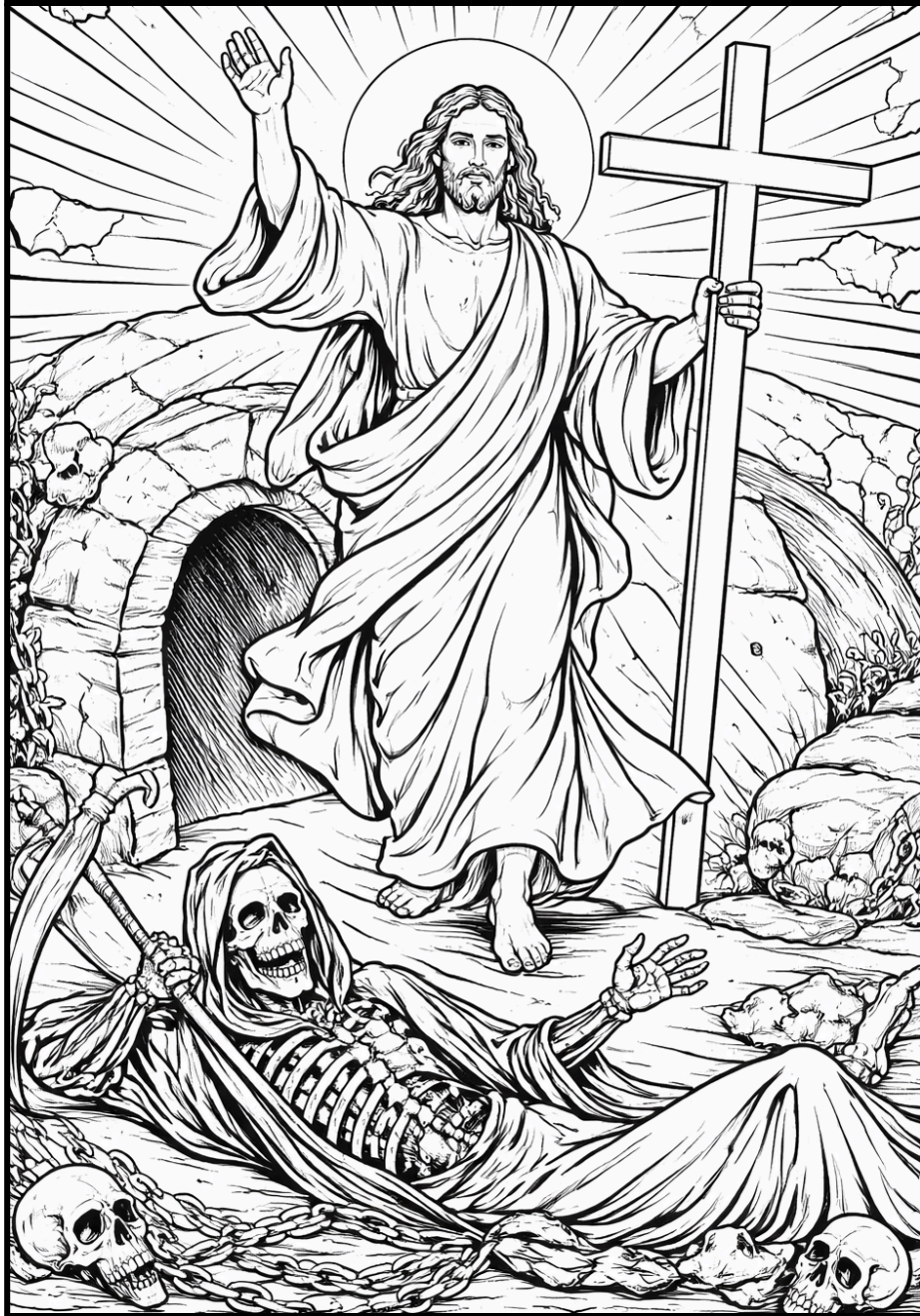

## Invocation

Father, Creator of Heaven and Earth, <sup>Gen 1:1</sup> ♦ **you created us to “serve and protect” your creation.** <sup>Gen 2:15</sup> ♦ But we destroy your creation <sup>Rev 11:18</sup> ♦ **through Civilization’s Way of arrogance, fear, and violence.** <sup>Gen 3:1—4:17</sup> ♦ So you send your Word in the flesh of your Son Jesus, <sup>John 1:14</sup> who says, ♦ **“Repent, for the Kingdom of Heaven has arrived! Deny yourself, take up your cross, and follow me!”** <sup>Matt 4:17, 16:24</sup> ♦ And you baptize us with your Holy Spirit <sup>Acts 1:5</sup> ♦ **so we might care for all your creation by following Jesus’s Way of “faith, hope, and love.”** <sup>1 Cor 13:13</sup>

Hear what Jesus says, ♦ **“Love the Lord your Creator with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind.** ♦ This is the first and great command. And the second is like it: ♦ **Love your neighbor as yourself.”** <sup>Matt 22:37-39</sup>

#### Confronting Our Past

(silence for reflection)

For prostituting ourselves with the false gods of Civilization, <sup>Ex 20:3</sup> ♦ **Father, forgive us.**

For trusting the works of human hands, especially money, <sup>Ex 20:4</sup> ♦ **Father, forgive us.**

For being hypocrites who misrepresent your name, <sup>Ex 20:7</sup> ♦ **Father, forgive us.**

For overworking land, animals, and each other, <sup>Ex 20:8</sup> ♦ **Father, forgive us.**

For not respecting our fathers and mothers in Christ, <sup>Ex 20:12</sup> ♦ **Father, forgive us.**

For being violent to our bodies and your creation, <sup>Ex 20:13</sup> ♦ **Father, forgive us.**

For degrading ourselves and others with our sexuality, <sup>Ex 20:14</sup> ♦ **Father, forgive us.**

For trying to possess and control your creation, <sup>Ex 20:15</sup> ♦ **Father, forgive us.**

For not being vulnerable and honest with others, <sup>Ex 20:16</sup> ♦ **Father, forgive us.**

For competing with others and desiring more, <sup>Ex 20:17</sup> ♦ **Father, forgive us.**

Jesus says, “Enter through the narrow Way. Because the Way of Destruction is wide and easy ♦ **and many enter through it.** ♦ But the Way of Life is narrow and difficult ♦ **and few find it.** <sup>Matt 7:13-14</sup> ♦ Whoever does not disown his own father, mother, wife, children, brothers, sisters, and even his own soul, ♦ **cannot be my disciple.** ♦ Whoever does not carry his own cross and follow me ♦ **cannot be my disciple.”** <sup>Luke 14:26-27</sup>

♪ ***Lord Father we have wandered and hidden from your face. Rescue your whole creation with your almighty grace. From trust in wealth and weapons and blindness to your Way, save us and all creation with your own hands, we pray.*** ♪ (LSB 449)

Jesus says, “I discipline those I love. Repent! I am standing at the door knocking!” <sup>Rev 3:19-20</sup> Come out of Civilization, my people, so you will not share in its sicknesses! <sup>Rev 18:4</sup>

Not one stone will be left standing, it will all be torn down.” <sup>Matt 24:2</sup> Will you turn away from Civilization’s Way of arrogance, fear, and violence and reaffirm your Baptism into Jesus’s Way of faith, hope, and love? ♦ **Yes, I renounce Civilization’s Way and pledge to follow Jesus.** ♦ Jesus says, “Blessed are the merciful, for they will receive mercy.” <sup>Matt 5:7</sup> If you forgive others, your heavenly Father will forgive you. <sup>Matt 6:14</sup> Put your sword away. If you take up the sword, you will die by the sword.” <sup>Matt 26:52</sup> Will you release all debts and grudges that you hold against anyone—including every member of this church? ♦ **Yes, I forgive all those who have hurt me, frustrated me, or owe me**

**anything.** ♦ Jesus says, “Your sins are forgiven. Get up and walk!” <sup>Matt 9:5</sup> Remember what you have heard and obey it!” <sup>Rev 3:3</sup> † **Amen.**

## † Words of Our Lord Jesus †

Jesus says, “Whoever humbles himself is the greatest in the Kingdom of Heaven.” <sup>Matt 18:4</sup> On the night before our Lord Jesus was crucified, he humbly washed the feet of his students and enemies. Jesus said, ♦ **“I have given you an example. Do as I have done for you. Love others. In the same way I have loved you, love others. By this all will know that you are my disciples: if you love each other.”** <sup>John 13:15, 34-35</sup> ♦ During supper, Jesus then took the bread and broke it. He gave it to them, saying, “This is my † body, given for you. Do the same in my memory.” After supper, Jesus then took the cup and gave thanks. He said, “This is my † blood of the covenant, poured out for you, for the forgiveness of sins. Do the same in my memory.” <sup>Matt 26:26-28, Luke 22:19-20</sup>

## Sharing the Bread & Wine

Jesus says, “I am the Bread of Life. Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood remains in me.” <sup>John 6:51, 56</sup> As we feed on the Bread of Life ♦ **we are made members of Christ’s Body.** <sup>1 Cor 10:16-17</sup> ♦ We no longer live for ourselves ♦ **but Christ lives within us.** <sup>Gal 2:20</sup> ♦ We invite all Baptized members of the universal Church, who give their undivided allegiance to Jesus and are at peace with their brothers and sisters in Christ, to join us ♦ **as the Creator’s Lamb mysteriously gives himself to us in, with, and under this bread, wine, and communion.**

*REFRAIN: ♫ This is the feast of victory for our God. Alleluia, alleluia, alleluia. ♫ ♫ Worthy is Christ, the Lamb who was slain, whose blood set us free to be people of God. (REFRAIN) ♫ Power, riches, wisdom and strength, and honor, blessing, and glory are his. (REFRAIN) ♫ Sing with all the people of God, and join in the hymn of all creation. Blessing, honor, glory, and might be to God and the Lamb forever. Amen. (REFRAIN) ♫ For the Lamb who was slain has begun his reign. Alleluia. (REFRAIN) ♫ (LSB 155)*
