

^{28.1} And after the Sabbaths, at dawn, on the first of the Sabbaths, Mary Magdalene and the other Mary came to see the grave. ² And look, a great shaking happened, for a messenger of the Lord, after coming down from heaven and after approaching, rolled away the stone and sat upon it. ³ And his appearance was like lightning and his clothing was white as snow. ⁴ And those guarding were shaken because of the fear of him and they became like dead men. ⁵ And answering, the messenger said to the women,

“You yourselves must not fear! For I know that you are seeking Jesus, the crucified one. ⁶ He is not here! For he was raised just as he said. Come, you must see the place where he was lying down. ⁷ And quickly, after journeying, you must tell his learners that he was raised from the dead. And look, he is going ahead of you into Galilee! There you will see him! Look, I spoke to you.”

⁸ And after quickly going away from the tomb with fear and great joy, they ran to report to his learners. ⁹ And look, Jesus met them, saying,

“You must rejoice!”

And after coming to him, the women grasped his feet and became-like-dogs before him. ¹⁰ Then Jesus is saying to them,

“You must not fear! Go, report to my brothers so that they should go away into Galilee and there they will see me.”

¹¹ And while they are journeying, look, some of the custodians, after coming into the city, reported to the ruler-priests all the things that happened. ¹² And after gathering with the elders and after taking a plan, they gave enough silvers to the soldiers, ¹³ saying,

“You must say, ‘His learners, after coming at night, stole him, while we were sleeping!’ ¹⁴ And if this might be heard by the Governor, then we ourselves will persuade him and we will make you worry-free.”

¹⁵ And after they took the silvers, they did as they were taught. And this word was spoken among the Judeans until today.

¹⁶ And the eleven learners journeyed into Galilee to the mountain where Jesus had commanded them. ¹⁷ And seeing him, they became-like-dogs. But they were divided. ¹⁸ And after coming, Jesus said to them, saying,

“All authority in heaven and upon earth was given to me. ¹⁹ Therefore, after journeying, you must disciple all ethnicities, while baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit, ²⁰ while teaching them to guard all things, as much as I commanded you. And look, I myself am with you all the days until the completion of the order-of-reality.”
