Invocation

Father, Creator of Heaven and Earth, ^{Gen 1:1} ♦ **you created us to “serve and protect” your creation.** ^{Gen 2:15} ♦ But we destroy your creation ^{Rev 11:18} ♦ **through Civilization’s Way of arrogance, fear, and violence.** ^{Gen 3:1—4:17} ♦ So you send your Word in the flesh of your Son Jesus, ^{John 1:14} who says, ♦ **“Repent, for the Kingdom of Heaven has arrived! Deny yourself, take up your cross, and follow me!”** ^{Matt 4:17, 16:24} ♦ And you baptize us with your Holy Spirit ^{Acts 1:5} ♦ **so we might care for all your creation by following Jesus’s Way of “faith, hope, and love.”** ^{1 Cor 13:13}

Remembering the Saints & Martyrs — Paulinus of Nola

Father, we give you thanks for the great cloud of saints and witnesses who have gone before us and have embodied the Way of Jesus. Today we remember Paulinus (354-431 AD) who, after being converted to the faith by his wife, left his career as a Roman governor and senator behind to follow Jesus. One of the wealthiest men in the entire world, he sold all of the family estates, became a bishop, and brought the poor and sick into his own home. Paulinus wrote: “We have no right to our possessions; they have been entrusted to us for the good of all. Let us then invest with the Lord what he has given us, for we have nothing that does not come from him: we are dependent upon him for our very existence. What can we regard as our own when we do not even possess ourselves?” Help us learn from his faith and example, † **Amen.**

Confronting Our Past

Jesus says, “I know what you do. I search minds and hearts and I will give to each of you according to your practices.” Rev 2:19, 23 Remove the log from your own eye!” Matt 7:5

Jesus says, “Whoever humbles himself is the greatest in the Kingdom of Heaven.” ^{Matt 18:4} On the night before our Lord Jesus was crucified, he humbly washed the feet of his students and enemies. Jesus said, ♦ **“I have given you an example. Do as I have done for you. Love others. In the same way I have loved you, love others. By this all will know that you are my disciples: if you love each other.”** ^{John 13:15, 34-35} ♦ During supper, Jesus then took the bread and broke it. He gave it to them, saying, “This is my ✠ body, given for you. Do the same in my memory.” After supper, Jesus then took the cup and gave thanks. He said, “This is my ✠ blood of the covenant, poured out for you, for the forgiveness of sins. Do the same in my memory.” ^{Matt 26:26-28, Luke 22:19-20}

Sharing the Bread & Wine

Jesus says, “I am the Bread of Life. Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood remains in me.” ^{John 6:51, 56} As we feed on the Bread of Life ♦ **we are made members of Christ’s Body.** ^{1 Cor 10:16-17} ♦ We no longer live for ourselves ♦ **but Christ lives within us.** ^{Gal 2:20} ♦ We invite all Baptized members of the universal Church, who give their undivided allegiance to Jesus and are at peace with their brothers and sisters in Christ, to join us ♦ **as the Creator’s Lamb mysteriously gives himself to us in, with, and under this bread, wine, and communion.** ♪ *We fall down now before you, Jesus you are the Lord. We lay our crowns before you, and put down all our swords. We give you all of our lives, we will hold nothing back. For you gave us everything, there is nothing we lack. You are the true Lamb of God, you gave your life for all. Teach us now to live like lambs, to trust you as we fall. ♪ (LSB 941)*
