

## Gen 25:1—26:35

<sup>25.1</sup> And after advancing, We-Are-Protected (Abraham) took a wife by the name of Incense (Keturah).

*[Gen 25:2-4 — Genealogy of Abraham's six sons from Keturah, which includes Midian.]*

<sup>5</sup> And We-Are-Protected gave all his possessions to Carefree (Isaac) his son. <sup>6</sup> To the sons of his concubines, We-Are-Protected gave gifts. And he sent them away from Carefree his son, while he was still living, to the springing-up, to the land of the springing-up. <sup>7</sup> And these are the years of days of life of We-Are-Protected as much as he lived, 175 years. <sup>8</sup> And after wasting-away, We-Are-Protected died at a beautiful old-age as an old-man and full of days and he was added to his people. <sup>9</sup> And Carefree (Isaac) and The-Creator-Listens (Ishmael) his two sons buried him in the double cave on the farm of Dust-Man (Ephron) of Dried-Up (Zohar) the Terrorist (Hittite), which is across from Understanding (Mamre). <sup>10</sup> The farm and the cave, which We-Are-Protected acquired from the sons of Fear (Heth), there they buried We-Are-Protected and Our-Lady (Sarah) his woman. <sup>11</sup> And it happened after We-Are-Protected died, the Creator blessed Carefree his son and Carefree housed alongside the Well of Vision.

<sup>12</sup> And these are the genesisises of The-Creator-Listens (Ishmael), the son of We-Are-Protected, who Forced (Hagar) the dependent of Our-Lady birthed for We-Are-Protected.

*[Gen 25:13-16 — Genealogy of Ishmael's twelve sons.]*

<sup>17</sup> And these are the years of life of The-Creator-Listens, 137 years and, after wasting-away, he died and was added to his group. <sup>18</sup> And he housed from Exhausted-Strength (Havilah) to Resurrection (Shur), which is against the face of Anxious-Security (Egypt) until coming to Prosperity (Assyria). He housed against the face of all his brothers.

<sup>19</sup> And these are the genesisises of Carefree (Isaac), the son of We-Are-Protected (Abraham). We-Are-Protected generated Carefree. <sup>20</sup> And Carefree was 45 years when he took Bound (Rebekah), the daughter of Virgin-of-the-Creator (Bethuel) the Elevated-One (Syrian) out of Between-the-Rivers (Mesopotamia), the sister of Empty (Laban) the Elevated-One, for himself as a woman. <sup>21</sup> And Carefree begged the Lord concerning Bound his woman because she was infertile. And the Creator listened to him and Bound his woman took in the belly. <sup>22</sup> And while the little-dependents were kicking within her, she said,

“If it is about to happen like this for me, then why is this happening to me?!”

And she journeyed to ask from the Lord. <sup>23</sup> And the Lord said to her,

“Two ethnicities are in your womb and two peoples will be sent-out from your belly. And a people will be over a people. And the greater will be the slave to the lesser.”

<sup>24</sup> And the days for her to birth were fulfilled and twins were in her belly. <sup>25</sup> And the first-born son came-out fire-red all-over like a hairy hide. And she named his name Leader (Esau). <sup>26</sup> And after this came-out his brother and his hand had been holding the heel of Leader. And she called his name Follower (Jacob). And Carefree was 60 years when Bound birthed them. <sup>27</sup> And the young-men grew. And Leader was a human having perceived to dog-hunt, a farm-housing-man. And Follower was an unformed human, housing at home. <sup>28</sup> And Carefree loved Leader because his hunted-beast was food for him. And Bound loved Follower.

<sup>29</sup> And Follower stewed a stew. And Leader came-out of the field, wasting-away. <sup>30</sup> And Leader said to Follower,

“I myself must taste from this fiery stew, because I am wasting-away!”

Because of this, his name was called Dying (Edom). <sup>31</sup> And Follower said to Leader,

“You must give-away to me today your first-born-privileges to me.”

<sup>32</sup> And Leader said,

“Look, I myself am coming to an end! So what are the firstborn-privileges to me?!”

<sup>33</sup> And Follower said to him,

“You must promise to me today!”

And he promised to him. And Leader gave-away the firstborn-privileges to Follower. <sup>34</sup> And Follower gave to Leader bread and a lentil stew. And he ate and drank and, after standing-up, he was leaving. And Leader treated-as-worthless the firstborn-privileges.

<sup>26.1</sup> And a food-shortage happened upon the land, a different food-shortage from the previous which happened in the time of We-Are-Protected. And Carefree went to My-Father-Is-Ruler (Abimelech), king of the Burrowers (Philistines) in Detachment (Gerar). <sup>2</sup> And the Lord appeared to him and said,

“You must not go-down into Anxious-Security (Egypt) and you must house in the land, whichever I tell you. <sup>3</sup> You must be-away-from-home in this land and I will be with you and I will bless you. For to you and to your seed I will

give all this land. And I will establish my promise which I promised to We-Are-Protected your father. <sup>4</sup> And I will multiply your seed like the stars of heaven and I will give to your seed all of this land. And all the ethnicities of the earth will be blessed by your seed. <sup>5</sup> Because We-Are-Protected your father obeyed my voice and protected my orders and my commands and my righteous-acts and my laws.”

<sup>6</sup> And Carefree housed in Detachment. <sup>7</sup> And the men of the place asked about Bound his woman and he said,  
“She is my sister.”

For he feared to say, “She is my woman,” or-else the men of the place might kill him over Bound because she was wonderful to the sight. <sup>8</sup> And much-time happened there and, after bending-down through the window, My-Father-Is-Ruler the king of Detachment saw Carefree playing with Bound his woman. <sup>9</sup> And My-Father-Is-Ruler called Carefree and said to him,

“Therefore indeed, she is your woman! Why did you say, ‘She is my sister’?!”

And Carefree said to him,

“For I said or-else I will die because of her!”

<sup>10</sup> And My-Father-Is-Ruler said to him,

“What is this you did to us?! Someone in my group almost bedded with your woman! And you brought upon us ignorance!”

<sup>11</sup> And My-Father-Is-Ruler ordered all his people, saying,

“Everyone touching this human or his woman will be caught-in death.”

<sup>12</sup> And Carefree scattered-seed in that land and found in that year the barley produced-a-hundredfold. And the Lord blessed him.

<sup>13</sup> And the human was lifted-up and, while going-forward, he was becoming great until he became very great. <sup>14</sup> And owned-animals of sheep and owned-animals of cows and many worked-lands happened for him. And the Burrowers were jealous of him.

<sup>15</sup> And all the wells, which the dependents of his father dug in the time of his father, the Burrowers blocked-in and filled them with earth. <sup>16</sup> And My-Father-Is-Ruler said to Carefree,

“You must go-away from us! Because you became much more-powerful than us!”

<sup>17</sup> And Carefree went-away from-there and unpacked in the ravine of Detachment (Gerar) and housed there. <sup>18</sup> And again Carefree dug the wells of water which the dependents of We-Are-Protected his father dug that the Burrowers (Philistines) closed-in after We-Are-Protected his father died. And he named their names according to the names which We-Are-Protected his father named them. <sup>19</sup> And the dependents of Carefree dug in the ravine of Detachment and found there a well of living water. <sup>20</sup> And the shepherds of Detachment fought with the shepherds of Carefree, claiming the water to be theirs. And he called the name of the well Unrighteousness for they were unrighteous to him. <sup>21</sup> And after going-away from-there, Carefree dug another well. And they also were judging about that and he named its name Enmity. <sup>22</sup> And after going-away from-there, he dug another well. And they did not fight about it and he named its name Enough-Space, saying,

“Because now the Lord was widening us and grew us upon the earth.”

<sup>23</sup> And he went-up from-there to the Well of the Oath. <sup>24</sup> And the Lord was seen by him during that night and said,

“I myself am the Creator of We-Are-Protected your father. You must not fear, for I am with you! And I have blessed you and I will multiply your seed because of We-Are-Protected your father.”

<sup>25</sup> And he built there an altar and called-upon the name of the Lord. And he set-up there his tent. And the dependents of Carefree dug there a well. <sup>26</sup> And My-Father-Is-Ruler journeyed to him from Detachment with Possess (Ahuzzath) his bride-escort and Sword-Edge (Phicol) the soldier-ruler of his power. <sup>27</sup> And Carefree said to them,

“Why did you come to me? Even you yourselves disowned me and sent me away from you.”

<sup>28</sup> And they said,

“After seeing, we have seen that the Lord was with you. And we said a supplication must happen between us and between you and we will covenant with you a covenant. <sup>29</sup> Not to do harm with us just-as we ourselves did not detest you and in the manner we treated you beautifully and we sent you out with peace. And now you are a blessed-one by the Lord.”

<sup>30</sup> And he made for them a feast and they ate and drank. <sup>31</sup> And after standing-up early, they promised, a human to his neighbor. And Carefree sent them out and they were going-away from him with salvation. <sup>32</sup> And it happened on that day and, after arriving, the dependents of Carefree reported to him about the well which they dug and they said,

“We did not find water.”

<sup>33</sup> So he called it Oath. Because of this the name for the city is Well of the Oath until today’s day.

<sup>34</sup> And Leader (Esau) was 45 years and he took a woman Praise-Him (Judith) the daughter of My-Well (Beeri) the Terrorist (Hittite) and Sweet-Smell (Basemath) daughter of Foolish (Elon) the Terrorist. <sup>35</sup> And they were conflicting with Carefree and Bound (Rebekah).
